Executive Summary Accreditation Report



Overview

From **May 26 to May 30, 2025**, Bayshore HealthCare's Integrated Care Solutions' (ICS) participated in a comprehensive on-site accreditation survey as part of Accreditation Canada's Qmentum Global™ program. This includes the At-Home/Community programs, the Neurological Rehabilitation Institute of Ontario (NRIO) residential homes and the Transitional Care Units (TCU) program.

A team of expert surveyors visited multiple ICS locations across Ontario—including client homes and NRIO residences—and conducted virtual assessments with leadership and frontline staff. Through interviews and on-site observations, they evaluated ICS against international best-practice and quality standards.

The ICS division was awarded **Accredited with Commendation**, recognizing its excellence in exceeding fundamental accreditation requirements.
